Raised and Negative Stenciling

Taught by Julie McDowell of Dandelions and Poppies

Course Overview:

1. View demonstration of dry wall compound application methods.
2. Using a putty knife, apply the compound through the stencil. Let dry.
3. Sand with 120-grit sandpaper until smooth, remove dust.
4. Apply Coastal Blue Milk Paint with a chip brush. Let dry.
5. Apply Copper Pearl Effects with stencil brush, highlighting raised areas. Let dry.

Materials:

- GF Coastal Blue
- GF Copper Pearl
- Dry wall compound
- 120 Grit Sand paper
- RDS Stencil
- RDS Stencil Brush
- Putty Knife
- Chip Brush
